So the little bird can fly away and come back whenever it wants. Nunu has just fed it pieces of apple- its favourite food- when the little bird is already gone again. And because the bird is often not here but elsewhere, it is also called „Elsewhere“. One day, however, it is Nunu and his family who have left their home, for war is raging in the city. Elsewhere also has to flee. A long journey into the unknown begins and Anderswo wonders if he will ever find his friend Nunu again.
