PETER AND THE WOLF [5 plus]

Peter lives with his grandfather in a little house at the edge of the forest. He understands the language of the cat, of the bird and the duck. The animals are his friends. His grandfather tells Peter to always keep the garden door locked, because the dangerous wolf lives in the forest. One day, Peter forgets to close the garden door and the disaster starts. The wolf comes and satisfies his hunger by eating the duck. But the brave Peter is not intimidated and catches the wolf with the help of the bird. Together with the hunters, the grandfather, the cat and the bird, Peter brings the wolf to the zoo.

All the characters in the fairy tale, humans as well as animals, are musically represented by instruments. Each character has his or her own instrument through which he or she is characterised:

- Peter – the violin and strings
- the bird – the flute
- the duck – the oboe,
- the cat – the clarinet,
- the grandfather – the bassoon,
- the wolf – the horns,
- the hunters – the timpani and the drum
